Welcome to Kindergarten

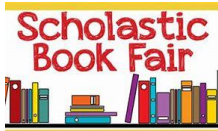
We will be having our 'Welcome to Kindergarten' event on May 8th from 3 – 4:30 pm for children/families who have registered for the 2025/2026 school year!
